ABSTRACTS

Special notes

The abstracts will be printed exactly as presented.

- Abstracts will not be considered unless accompanied by the presenting author 's registration Form
- Abstract will not be considered if previously published
- Abstract will not be considered if they do not give data. " Results " will be discussed " is not acceptable.

Courses /Workshop/ Symposia are selected by Scientific Program Committee based on proposals submitted.

Structured abstracts are required 300 words.

- **as Scientific Review Presentation**
- **as Original Works - Poster or Oral Presentation as traditional way.**

ABSTRACT RULES:

Background and Purpose

Describe the rationale of the study and the precise objective or question addressed in the report.

Design

Describe the basic study design: randomized controlled trial, studies of screening and diagnostic tests, case report, studies of prognosis, studies that include a formal economic evaluation, .. .

Materials and Methods

As for Participants, state:

- clinical disorders
- eligibility criteria
- sociodemographic features
- number of participants
- characteristics of matched groups
- rate of participants survived at the follow up and rate of participants who withdrew due to adverse effects.

Describe the statistical analysis used.

Main Outcome Measure(s)

Indicate the primary study outcome measurement(s) as planned before data collection began.

Results

- Provide the main study results.
- Indicate whether observers were blinded to patient groupings, particularly for subjective measurements.
- Results must be given in narrative rather than tabular form.
- If possible, the results should be accompanied by CIs (eg, 95%) and the exact level of statistical significance.
- For comparative studies, CIs should relate to the differences between groups.
- For nonsignificant differences for the major study outcome measure(s), state the clinically important difference sought and give the CI for the difference between the groups.
- Report no data in the abstract that do not appear in the article.

Conclusion(s)

- Conclusions must be directly supported by the evidence reported.
- Avoid speculation and overgeneralization, and indicate whether additional study is required before the information should be used in usual clinical settings.

References

Only material that is retrievable through standard literature searches must be used in the manuscripts (max 3 references accepted).
